### Study drug and design:

AbbVie is testing two drugs that are approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and are currently available on the market. The objective of this study is to compare the bioavailability (the amount of drug absorbed by the body into the blood) when comparing different formulations under a fasting condition.

### Minimum Subject Selection Criteria:

*YOU may be eligible to take part in this clinical study if you meet the following conditions:*

- ◆ Healthy men and women 20-40 years old.
- ◆ Females must be: Permanently surgically sterile, postmenopausal for 1 year, or fertile and willing to practice study specific birth control.
- ◆ Average weight for height (BMI  $\geq 18.5$  to  $\leq 25$  kg/m<sup>2</sup>).
- ◆ Not taking any medications or herbal remedies or supplements.
- ◆ No history of gastrointestinal surgical operations including removal of the gallbladder.
- ◆ No history of any drug sensitivity or allergy.
- ◆ No history of drug or alcohol abuse for 6 months.
- ◆ Non-user of tobacco for at least 6 months.
- ◆ No blood or blood product donation after July 10, 2019.
- ◆ No other study participation after August 25, 2019.
- ◆ Must be 30 days away from last first in human study.
